- Pieces will be judged on creativity, presentation, and relevance
- Submit completed work to the Garst Museum by July 15, 2016
- Pieces must include a title, name, age, grade, school, and phone number on the back.
- Students are encouraged to bring supplies: post cards, photographs, magazines, textiles, etc.

All pieces submitted will be displayed at The Gathering at Garst, July 30th and 31st. Cash prizes will be awarded as follows:
